# ANSWERS

**1. Robin writes the email. (Present Simple Tense)**

**The email is written by Robin.**

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**2. Esther is sending an email to her student. (Present Continuous Tense)**

**Esther's student is being sent an email by her.**

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**3. The student has finished the homework. (Present Perfect Tense)**

**The homework has been finished by the student.**

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**4. The student finished the homework. (Past Simple Tense)**

**The homework was finished by the student.**

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**5. The maid was cleaning the room. (Past Continuous Tense)**

**The room was being cleaned by the maid.**

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**6. The policeman had helped the lost boy. (Past Perfect Tense)**

**The lost boy had been helped by the policeman.**

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**7. Electricity will turn on the lights. (Future Simple Tense)**

**The lights will be turned on by electricity.**

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**8. The dog will be eating his food. (Future Continuous Tense)**

**His food will be being eaten by the dog.**

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**9. The storm will have damaged the road. (Future Perfect Tense)**

**The road will have been damaged by the storm.**

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
